
to install and maintain Ondas de Esperanza, the radio station. They are working in an English church in Vilcabamba, where people from other

Prayer Guide for the Ecuador Mission Trip Oct. 25 to Nov. 4

Here's how you can pray daily for the team:



<u>Wednesday, October 25</u> The purpose of this trip is to distribute 800 players that have a Spanish audio Bible and Mini Spanish Bible College, as well as the ability to receive the *Ondas de Esperanza* (Waves of Hope) radio station, and also to encourage the missionaries and people who work at the radio station. The team is comprised of two groups, five from Tsawwassen Alliance Church (TAC) in BC and three from Ontario. Pray for the
